To complete this course, participants must complete the following:

- Completion of 18-hour online self-paced course and 80% or higher:
- An outline of a Core of Knowledge (CKO) training topic including an overview, objectives, and summary statement with two key points. (see attached template)
- A 15-minute training presentation.

Training presentation instructions:

- To complete the training presentation assignment, participants must develop a PowerPoint presentation on a topic of their choice.
- Participants are required to record a video of themselves presenting the PowerPoint.
- Presentations will be graded on organization, content, and presentation of the training.

Rubric

Scoring is numerical: 0,3,4,5 (5 being the highest)

The organization of the training includes the PowerPoint presentation, training proposal, and any other accompanying training documentation.

- Written materials including handouts, PowerPoint slides, trainer note pages, planning template, etc., use quality writing, grammar, spelling, and mechanics. **Score**
- Maintains consistency within the training proposal: description, learning objectives, content, and methods are highly consistent with one another. Score
- Specifies realistic and measurable learning objectives: All of the learning objectives are realistic and written in measurable terms. **Score**
- Resources cited are reputable, published within 5-7 years, and appropriate for use as the foundation of training content. Score
- Timeline allows adequate time for content, activities, assessment, and evaluation (excluding breaks).

The content of the training includes the information the trainer will present to learners, as well as the training title, description, and objectives.

- The training description clearly explains the content of the training, the need for the training, and the benefits to the participants. **Score**
- The training title uses strength-based language and appropriately refers to the subject of the training.
- Training proposal provides sufficient information specific to training content and objectives. Score
- Learning objectives and methods to measure learning are clearly addressed in the content. Score
- Addresses special needs such as adaptations, modifications, inclusionary practices, person first language, and ADA guidelines for both the participants and the population they serve. Score
- Content addresses cultural sensitivity and diversity for both the participants and the population they serve. Score
- Addresses housing insecurity for both the participants and the population they serve. Score
- Matches the targeted Core of Knowledge content area(s). Score
- Reflects current national standards/guidelines and best practices. Score

The presentation of the training includes the handouts, PowerPoint, visuals, and how the trainer presents the content and engages with participants.

- Provides quality materials and handouts that are appropriate and user-friendly, look professional, and have appropriate reference information. **Score**
- Connects training content to practical application. Score
- Methods of Delivery: Methods clearly reflect a variety of learning styles, methods are clearly
 appropriate for adult learners, and methods clearly promote active learning. Score
- The presenter provides explicit explanation and illustration of the specific content knowledge and practice(s) to be learned. **Score**
- The learning objectives are clearly explained to participants. Score
- The content can easily be understood and adapted to the needs and level of the audience. Score
