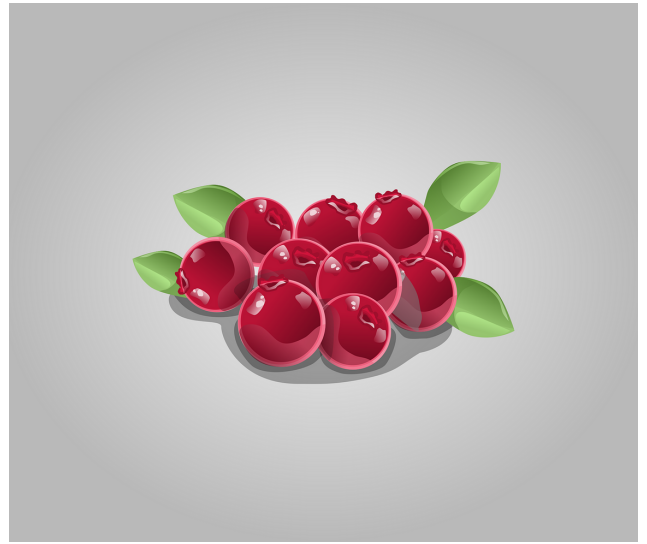
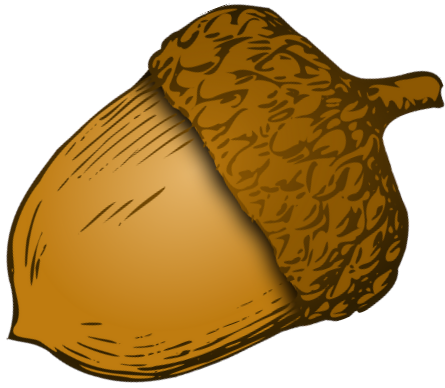

Thanksgiving Memory Game

Thank you for downloading this FREE resource at ChildCareEd! This activity can be printed out in either color or black/white. These flashcards can be used in a memory game for an individual, pair, or small group activity.

Materials:

1. Cards (two copies make one set), cut out and laminated on construction paper.

Directions:

1. Children will lay all cards face down. When they flip over two cards, they will determine if the picture is or is not the same. If the two cards are not the same, the cards will be flipped back down again. If they are the same card, children get to keep the cards.
2. The person with the most matched cards wins the game.
