How to Use This Resource:

Thank you for downloading this FREE resource at ChildCareEd! This fun activity combines the Thanksgiving theme with learning about numbers, shapes, and words. This activity requires the following materials:

- Construction paper (to glue the turkey on)
- Construction paper (either cut into rectangles or smaller pieces that children can cut into rectangles)
- "My turkey has..." statements (page 2) printed and cut
- Circles page (page 3) copied on brown paper
- Triangles (page 4) copied on orange paper

Directions:

- 1. Depending on the age group, the teacher can direct children to cut rectangles with scissors or pre-cut rectangles for younger children. The same can be done for the brown circles.
- 2. Direct children to create their turkey, and then write the number of circles, triangles, and rectangles they used in the statements provided. The teacher can direct children to glue the statement onto the paper or tape them to their artwork once they're finished.
