

## Materials:

- Hibernate/Migrate/Adapt sheets (printed and laminated)
- Animal cards (printed and laminated)
- Dry-erase markers and erasers (optional)

- Guide/facilitate children in sorting each animal as either hibernating, migrating, or adapting in winter.
