

## Creating the CDA Home Visitor Family Resource Guide

The CDA Home Visitor Professional Portfolio Resource Collection includes section **RC IV**. In this section, you are required to provide a Family Resource Guide which contains information you might choose to share with the families you serve. The Guide should include all of the helpful information you think they might need. The list below details what is required; however, applicants can add additional resources they may find pertinent.

Required information includes:

- RC IV-1 Local agency that provides family counseling.
- RC IV-2 Translation service and Sign Language.
- RC IV-3 Two agencies that provide resources and services for children with disabilities.
- RC IV-4 Three or more websites that provide current information to help families understand how young children develop and learn. These websites must feature articles that directly relate to the age group for which you are seeking the CDA Credential. Also included in this section are three (3) current articles, one from each website, that relate to child guidance and/or development.
