Math Skills: Counting, number recognition, and basic addition.

Fine Motor Skills: Handling marshmallows and placing them onto the mittens.

Sensory Development: Engaging with soft, squishy marshmallows stimulates tactile senses.

Creative Thinking: Decorating mittens and thinking about how to use numbers.

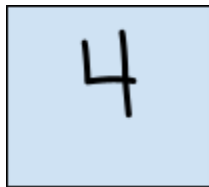
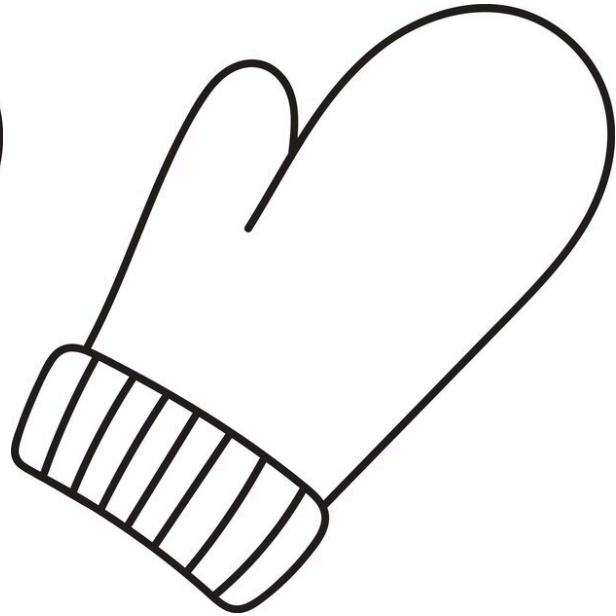
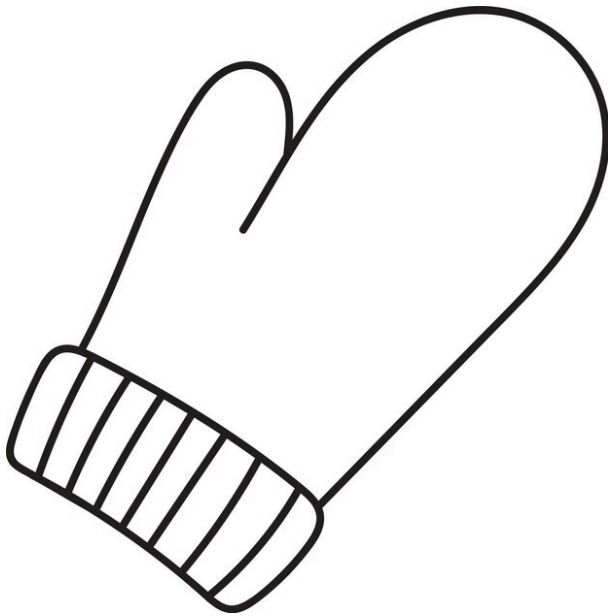
What you need:

- Marshmallows (mini or regular size)

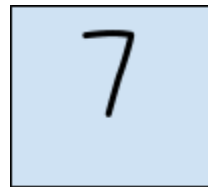
Directions:
