CDA Steps for the Birth to Five CDA® Credential

Step 1: Prepare

• Education Requirement:

Hold a high school diploma, GED, or be a junior/senior in a high school career/technical education program in early childhood education.

• Training Hours:

- Complete 120 clock hours of formal early childhood education covering children birth to five.
- o Must include at least 10 hours in each of the eight CDA® Subject Areas.

• Work Experience:

- Accumulate 480 hours of work (paid or volunteer) in the past three years.
- Must include 160 hours with each sub-age group:
 - Infants (Birth–17 months)
 - Toddlers (18–36 months)
 - Preschoolers (3–5 years).
- Experience must be in a center-based setting (not babysitting, drop-in care, or Sunday school).

Portfolio Preparation:

- Purchase the Competency Standards Book for Birth to Five (magenta cover).
- Develop a Professional Portfolio that addresses all three sub-age groups.
- Required forms and details will be in the Birth to Five CDA® Competency Standards book.

Step 2: Apply.

- Application Cost: \$525 (same as other settings).
- Submit Application Online:
 - Provide personal and center director's email.
 - Include your PD Specialist ID number.
- PD Specialist Selection:
 - Must be endorsed for Birth to Five.
 - o Can be found via the Find-a-PD Specialist Tool on YourCouncil.org.
- Once approved, you'll receive a "Ready to Schedule" notice for your exam and verification visit.



Step 3: Demonstrate

This step includes both the **Verification Visit** and the **CDA® Exam**:

Verification Visit

- Conducted by a Birth to Five-endorsed PD Specialist.
- Takes place at a state-licensed or legally exempt child development center.
- You will be observed working with:
 - At least 3 children (birth-36 months) or
 - At least 6 children (ages 3–5 years).
- During the visit, the PD Specialist will:
 - Review your Professional Portfolio.
 - o **Observe** your work with children.
 - Conduct a reflective dialogue.

CDA® Exam

- Administered through Pearson VUE testing centers.
- Format: Multiple-choice (about 65 questions, including scenarios).
- Time: 1 hour 55 minutes.
- Must be completed before your Verification Visit.

Timeline: You have **6 months** from your "Ready to Schedule" notice to complete both the Exam and Verification Visit.

Step 4: Earn

- You do not receive a simple "pass/fail."
- The Council reviews both the Exam and Verification Visit performance.
- If successful, you will be awarded the CDA® Credential: Birth to Five setting.

Step 5: Renew

- The Birth to Five CDA® Credential is valid for **3 years** from issue date.
- Renewal requires proof of continuing education, professional development, and maintaining your role in early childhood education.
