September Activity Idea: Leaf Sorting & Color Matching



Materials Needed:

- A variety of autumn leaves (different colors, sizes, and shapes)
 - Small baskets or trays for sorting
- Paint chips or fabric swatches in autumn tones
 - Paper and crayons for rubbings

Steps:

- 1. Invite children to collect or choose leaves for the activity.
- 2. Encourage them to sort by color, size, or shape using the baskets.
- 3. Provide **paint chips or fabric swatches** and let children match the leaves to the closest color—turning it into a fun matching challenge.
- 4. Extend the activity by making **leaf rubbings**: place a leaf under paper and use crayons to reveal its shape and texture.
