# How to Find and Work with a CDA PD Specialist

(For the Birth to Five CDA Credential)

Once you've **completed your 120 hours of training, 480 hours of work experience, and your Professional Portfolio**, the next step is to work with a **Professional Development (PD) Specialist** to complete your **Verification Visit**. This is one of the final steps in earning the CDA Credential.

## When to Choose a PD Specialist

Begin searching for a PD Specialist after you've finished your portfolio but before submitting your CDA application.

- Once your application is approved, you'll receive a "Ready to Schedule" notice from the Council for Professional Recognition.
- You'll then take the CDA Exam first and schedule your Verification Visit afterward.
- You have 6 months from the time your application is approved to complete both the exam and visit.

#### How to Find a PD Specialist

- 1. Log in to YourCouncil
  - Go to <u>cdacouncil.org</u> and log in to your YourCouncil dashboard.
- 2. Access the Directory
  - Select "Find a PD Specialist" from the left-hand menu.
- 3. Search by Location
  - Search by zip code (set at least a 5-mile radius) or by city and state.
  - Apply filters for specialization and language if you're completing your CDA in a language other than English.
- 4. Review and Contact
  - Click red pins on the map to see details for Specialists in your area.
  - Select "Contact" to send a request. Specialists typically respond within 48 hours.



 Once confirmed, enter the Specialist's name and Council ID into your CDA application.

### **Scheduling Your Verification Visit**

- After you've passed the CDA Exam and received your "Ready to Schedule" notice, coordinate a time for your Verification Visit.
- During the visit, your Specialist will:
  - Observe you working with either at least 3 infants/toddlers (birth-36 months) or 6 preschoolers (3-5 years).
  - Review your **Professional Portfolio**.
  - Conduct a Reflective Dialogue about your teaching practices.

#### **Key PD Specialist Requirements**

- Must hold the Birth to Five Endorsement.
- Cannot be your current employer, coworker, or anyone with a financial/contractual relationship with you.
- Must be a CDA Council—approved Specialist listed in the official directory.
