

# REQUIREMENTS

## Core of Knowledge (COK) Training:

Participants must complete training in six key topics:

1. Child Development
2. Curriculum
3. Professionalism
4. Community
5. Special Needs
6. Health, Safety, and Nutrition

Training may be taken from a college, university, or an OCC-approved trainer.

## Experience:

Participants must work directly with children in an approved setting for a number of years according to credential level.

## Professional Activity Units (PAUs):

Participants must do activities related to the child care profession, such as professional association membership, working with state or national accreditation organizations, peer mentoring, or developing newsletters.

  - 2 years of experience
  - 3 PAUs
- 4+**
  - Level 4 requirements, and
  - NAFCC accreditation or 15 college credit hours of approved coursework for option 2 or 3.
- 5**
  - Associate's Degree with 15 semester hours of approved coursework for option 2 or 3
  - 2 years experience
  - 4 PAUs
- 6**
  - Bachelor's Degree or higher in an approved major for option 2 or 3
  - 2 years experience
  - 5 PAUs

# ADMINISTRATOR CREDENTIAL LEVELS

- 1**
  - 240 clock hours COK training
  - 2 years experience
  - 4 PAUs.
- 2**
  - 240 clock hours COK training
  - National Administrator's Credential
  - 30 semester hours approved college coursework
  - 2 years experience
  - 5 PAUs
- 3**
  - Associate's Degree with 15 semester hours of approved coursework related to business management, administration, and
  - At least 1 college course in Child Development, Curriculum, or Administration of Child Care Programs
- 4**
  - Bachelor's Degree or higher in business administration, public administration and management, or public school administration
  - Completion of at least 1 college course for credit in Child Development, Curriculum, or Administration of Child Care Programs
  - Completion of 45 clock hours of training in mentoring and coaching.
